### Project Description / Scope:

This project initially proposed replacing all the T8 lamps within SCID with 10W Philips Instafit drop-in LED lamps, keeping existing ballasts and fixtures in place. After it was approved by the Committee, there were some concerns regarding emergency egress lighting, and the potential incompatibility of a drop-in replacement LED for these fixtures. Additionally there are concerns that keeping the existing ballast and fixtures will require replacing ballasts as they fail, or replacing fixtures as the ballasts fail, which result in the TLED being used for a period significantly shorter than its rated life. FM proposes developing a scenario with a full fixture replacement, including lighting controls and updated egress lighting.

Additions to Project Description / Scope (Include date addition was approved by Committee):

After going through the robust campus process for campus planning, design, and permitting with in-house experts and in consultation with third party vendor Frontier Consulting Engineers, the project scope developed into the following: this project includes the removal of the existing ballasts at existing T8 luminaires and replacement of existing T8 lamps with LED retrofit kits to achieve the goal of decreased power consumption.
