The San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge is a 45,730-acre (185.1 km²) wildlife conservation area along the coast of **Texas (USA)**, south of the towns of Sweeny and Brazoria, Texas. It encloses a bay behind a barrier island at the Gulf of Mexico. The refuge is located in southern Brazoria and eastern Matagorda counties.
