How to Write a Program Bio

- 1. Use third person.
- 2. Combine items in longer sentences.
- 3. Only use acronyms if the audience is sure to understand.
- 4. It is customary to recognize your current flute teacher, and other flute teachers of significance if space allows.
- 5. List non-music interests if you like, if space allows.
- 6. Always abide by the character or word count requested.
