Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

On August 13, 2025, the NJDOE announced new, mandatory statewide assessments: the New Jersey Student Learning Assessments-Adaptive (NJSLA-Adaptive) and the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment-Adaptive (NJGPA-Adaptive). These assessments will be aligned with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) for ELA and mathematics, and are designed to continue to give students the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in a meaningful way. These assessments reflect an effort to improve the testing experience while maintaining a strong connection to the NJSLS. Additional information about the new Adaptive tests can be found on the NJDOE's Students & Families website.

As part of this rollout, all schools must issue a Fall Field Test for the NJSLA-Adaptive and the NJGPA-Adaptive. We will be administering these assessments on the mornings of Wednesday, November 12th and Friday, November 14th. Those who do not have to test will have a delayed opening, and there will be an amended schedule in the afternoon for all students.

Who Must Participate:


- NJGPA-Adaptive English Language Arts (ELA Reading & ELA Writing)
 - All students enrolled in grade 11
- NJSLA-Adaptive
 - English Language Arts (ELA Reading & ELA Writing)
 - All students enrolled in grades 9 and 10
 - Mathematics
 - All students currently enrolled in grade 9; and
 - Any student who was enrolled in Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2 *last school year* (2024-2025); this includes all 10th graders, most 11th graders, and about half of the 12th graders.

We have flowcharts and testing day schedules for you on the next pages to help further assess what subject(s) you/your child needs to take, and what time to report; however, please feel free to contact your child's school counselor if you have any questions. We will provide another communication as the test dates near regarding testing locations, supplies, and procedures. Thank you.
