Carli Gribov (US) I am the Co-founder of OnRamps Onboarding, an organization that partners with companies to **make employee onboarding better**. Onboarding is one of the most crucial points in an employee's experience at work and oftentimes the most overlooked due to lack of organizational ownership (who does this!?) and manager time and skill. We partner with you to review existing processes, build custom tools (90 day plans, learning arcs, evaluation systems) and programs (training programs) to decrease new employee time to value and increase a sense of belonging and manager bandwidth. We've worked with everyone from a 120 person nonprofit to a 5,000 person \$5B business to overhaul their onboarding systems, resulting in an 80% increase in employee satisfaction and preparedness. Because onboarding is oftentimes the tip of the iceberg, we also work with companies to consult on larger people operations challenges such as hiring/recruiting, performance management, organizational culture and manager effectiveness.
