"The land upon which we gather is part of the traditional territory of the Lenni-Lenape, called "Lenapehoking." The Lenape People lived in harmony with one another upon this territory for thousands of years. During the colonial era and early federal period, many were removed west and north, but some also remain among the continuing historical tribal communities of the region: The Nanticoke Lenni-Lenape Tribal Nation; the Ramapough Lenape Nation; and the Powhatan Renape Nation, The Nanticoke of Millsboro Delaware, and the Lenape of Cheswold Delaware. We acknowledge the Lenni-Lenape as the original people of this land and their continuing relationship with their territory. In our acknowledgment of the continued presence of Lenape people in their homeland, we affirm the aspiration of the great Lenape Chief Tamanend, that there be harmony between the indigenous people of this land and the descendants of the immigrants to this land, "as long as the rivers and creeks flow, and the sun, moon, and stars shine."



Activities (subject to change)

Half time

- The Greatest Bag race Games 1 and 2
 - 2 contestants compete to retrieve items from inside the Greatest Bag which will be in the center of the field. They each have 1 minute to grab what they can get. They can only grab 1 item at a time. We will hide items throughout the bag. Winners keep what they retrieve!
- match fit Agility race Game 3
 - o Our first match fit performance challenge will test agility and accuracy in throws.
 - We have 2 teams of 2 who will race through the speed ladder while doing the icky shuffle, sprint to the cone, and turn around to receive a disc.
 - They will then run the disc back to the line while the next person takes off.
 - The first team to cross back over the starting line will win!
 - Winners will get 4 passes to FLGX NJ
- Frisbee hot potato Finals
 - Two people stand 10 feet apart and see how many consecutive passes they can complete in 1 minute. If they drop the disc they must start over. The team with the most passes wins!
 - Winner will get a PUL special edition Team Patch Sweatshirt (size M)

Post-game

- The teams will high five and do a spirit circle.
- Fans will be invited down to the field to listen in and get pictures and autographs. Before interacting with the fans, please make sure you mask up! (NOTE: If a fan is not wearing a mask, players/coaches do not need to interact with them or get within 6 feet.)
