General Information

Rosetta Stone's "Extended Learning" activities allow extra reading and listening practice that is designed to accompany each unit within the whole curriculum. In "Stories," students are provided with level-appropriate stories that match the vocabulary and grammar forms presented in the unit they are currently studying. The stories include vocabulary with images to support understanding, audio versions of each passage to promote listening comprehension, and speaking activities where the students are able to record themselves reading the text. With the recordings feature, students are able to play back the recording and they are also provided with visual feedback on the words they may have mispronounced.

In addition, the "Extended Listening" activities offer further listening practice to accompany each unit. In extended listening, students can download mp3 files that support the grammar and vocabulary from the unit, enabling students to practice their listening skills whether they have access to the Internet or not. The extended listening activities focus on pronunciation, vocabulary, phrases, and conversation, each prompting the students to listen to and repeat what they are learning in the unit, beginning with syllables and progressing to complete conversations.
