#### **MRS ATHERTON - SENCO**

Mrs Atherton has added to her job titles. Not only is she Assistant Head, she is Phase Leader for Years 1 and 2, Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead and since the start of this academic year, she is now our Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO).

It is Mrs Atherton's role to oversee SEN within our school to help children with special educational needs thrive. She works closely with teachers, parents and external agencies ensuring that everyone has a common goal where our child is at the heart. If you have any concerns over special educational needs please see your child's class teacher in the first instance.



#### READING

We believe that some learning beyond the school day can have a really beneficial impact on the progress that all children can make. The most important element of their homework, whether in Year 1 or Year 6, is to read for at least 10 or 15 minutes every day. Younger children should read with an adult, which provides an opportunity to encourage, correct and question the emerging reader. Older children can read independently, but still benefit massively from opportunities to clarify, discuss and share their reading with an adult. We would be grateful if reading was recorded in the children's reading diaries as this allows the school to track the pace and frequency with which individual children are reading. Thanks for all your support in helping our children to become fluent and confident readers.

#### **OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN WITH SEND**

The school has been made aware of some clubs run by Bexley Snap which are available for children with SEND in the borough.

• 'Early Years' For ages – 1 to 5 running Thursday and Friday sessions during term time

They are based at Normandy SEND Hub, Barnehurst. They have access to a large playroom, outside play area, ball pool and a new sensory room. They deliver term time sessions Snap's team concentrate on helping to increase all areas of children's development, helping them to be ready for school. The club is £2 a session.

• 'Little Explorers' For ages 5 to 11 running Saturday during term time.

They are also based at Normandy SEND Hub. As one of Bexley Snap commissioned services they offer young disabled children the chance to come along and play with other children in a safe and caring environment. They will experience the chance to play both inside and outside in our garden on the newly laid Astroturf. They will also be able to try new themed arts and crafts and messy or sensory play which will encourage children to engage with their peers and will help develop their fine motor skills and social skills. Their sensory room offers a space for calm, comfort and relaxation. The club is £2 a session.
