REAPS Reading Method

READ

Open your Bible and ask the Holy Spirit to teach, rebuke, correct, and train you, and guide you into all truth.

- What is happening in this passage?
- What things are emphasized, repeated, related?
- What do I not understand?

EXAMINE

Spend time prayerfully reflecting.

- What do you learn about who God is and His nature and character?
- What is the Lord doing in this passage?
- What do you learn about humanity?
- How do you think the author wants his audience to respond?
- Where do you see God's grace and truth spoken of and/or shown?

APPLY

After examining the passage, apply the text to your life.

- How are God's people called to live in light of this passage?
- Where do I need to repent, change and agree with the Lord?
- What truths do I need to believe and lies that I need to reject?
- What can I do today, empowered by the Holy Spirit, to apply this passage?

PRAY

Pray through the passage asking God to sanctify and transform your heart.

SHARE

Share what God taught you with at least one person—group members, people in your household, etc. What is one significant takeaway?

We'd encourage you to invite another believer or two to join you in this reading.
