Writing Guidelines

- **Be conversational and engaging.** Ask questions frequently and be friendly in the post. Try to relate to reader situations and stories.
- **Short, concise sentences are preferred.** Convey your ideas as simply and clearly as possible. Avoid fluff/filler words for the sake of word count.
- **Use everyday vocabulary** – this isn't an academic paper.

DO NOT

1. **DON'T include full technical data lists** (dimensions, lumens, color temperature etc.). Just mention key points or key features in a review. There will be a separate table with all that data you could refer to.

2. **DON'T copy** or quote any of the reviews from various sources. You could only rewrite them in your own way.

4. **DON'T try to link product features with benefits using a lot of sentences** like

- "This product has [feature], which is great because..."
- "Another good feature is [feature], which can help you with..."

5. **DON'T try to mention personal stories** when linking features and benefits like

- That would have been really useful when <insert story>.
- I really appreciate that feature considering <some personal issue or story>

6. **No salesy language.**

- **Wrong:** "You'll find peace of mind when your dog finally stops barking!"
- **Wrong:** "You can rest easy knowing your dog behavior troubles are finally over."
- **Wrong:** Anything else that sounds like it could be in an infomercial
- Instead, use *conditional* language ("If," "might," "could," etc.) if you make recommendations:
 - **Correct:** "This *might* be a good choice for those who want an in-home training option."
 - **Correct:** "*If* it's important to you to find a positive dog trainer, this *might* be a good place to start."

7. **No filler language**

- Please, every sentence should *add information*.

8. **Reference to sources**

Refer to at least three sources from "google scholar"
