We have already exceeded our goal of having 80% of student laptops checked out prior to the first day of school. Mr. Johnson will be available in the media center this week for students to pick up their laptop. Students or parents just need to bring in the signed laptop agreement to get the laptop. We will have blank forms available at school for anyone that needs a copy.

Students and parents will see "Success Academy" listed on their child's schedule. This is your student's homeroom teacher. We will go to Success Academy the first week of school and then we only occasionally will students go to their homeroom.

We will be administering the PSAT at Southeast Alamance High School on Tuesday, October 24th. The PSAT is a practice test that prepares students for success on the SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test), a commonly required college placement test. The PSAT is open to students in grades 10 and 11. The PSAT is optional and students that want to take the PSAT must register by September 3rd by completing the registration form below. There is a fee of \$18 for students that

want to take the PSAT. The fee must be paid to Mrs. Alexis Crumel by September 16th. Mrs. Crumel will be in the cafeteria each day during lunch to accept cash or check payment.
