

In SEL we will continue to do check-ins and prepare for summer without all of our friends. We have been going over happiness and now will tie that into being happy when we're not with our friends.

G1, G2 and G3 students participated in Chinese CMT and CFB to do online activities including role playing, discussing stories, and writing the Chinese characters.




Thai class with Keu Fai




