- **Call to Order**
 - Cassie 6:10 pm
- **Reading of the Minutes**
 - Ann Marie Louzon waive, Jenn Saunders second
- **Principals Report - Jenn P**
 - Kids have been good, there are a lot of assessments so the kids are very busy, there has been a tremendous amount of growth this year
- **Treasurer's Report - Gail**
 - Checking: \$6115.47
 - Savings: \$33613.95
 - Library Funds: \$1416.81
 - OLS: \$4445.20
- **Old Business**
 - Book Fair - thank you Sherri, Jill, and Jenn for running
 - Sherri - profits: no profits on BOGO sale. Scholastic profit \$4381.47, translates to same value of books for students. Purchased/ordered summer reading books. Delay due to Scholastic warehouse closed for inventory until 6/9. Should still arrive on time
