

Meridian High School Supply List 2018-2019

This is a basic list of school supplies for the school year. Teachers may request 1-2 more supply items throughout the year.

Note that the supplies below (pens, pencils, paper, glue sticks, etc.) will need to be replenished throughout the year as they run out.

9th and 10th Grade

General Supplies for all classes:

- 1 or 2 large binders for all classes (student choice: either 1 for all 8 classes or 2, one for A day classes and one for B day classes)
- tab dividers (2 packages)
- Set of 12 colored Pencils
- Pencil(s)
- Pen(s) (blue or black)
- Highlighter(s)
- Soft pencil case
- Scotch tape
- Post-it notes
- Planner (optional, but recommended)
- Earbuds (always keep in backpack)

Items to Bring and Leave in 1st Period Classroom

- 2 reams of copy paper
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

- 1 Composition Notebook

English 2 (10th grade)

- 1 composition notebook
- 1 ½" binder
- 1 set of dividers - 5 count

World Geography (9th grade)

- 1 1 ½" Binder

Biology (9th grade)

- 1 box of disposable gloves
- 1 composition book, any line format
- 1" binder

Chemistry (10th grade)

- 1 box of disposable gloves
- 2 composition books, any line format

Geometry (9th grade)

- Spiral Notebook - 3 subject, college ruled with plastic cover
- Compass and Straightedge (like a ruler)

Algebra 2 (10th grade)

- Three ring binder
- Spiral Notebook - 1 subject

Physics (elective 10th-12th grade)

- 1 composition book, any line format, grid recommended, 100 sheets, 200 pages

Computer Science (elective 9th-12th grade)

- 1 composition book, any line format 100 sheets, 200 pages

Visual Arts (note: not all HS students are in Art):

- Hardcover sketchbook 8 1/2 x11
- Drawing/shading pencil set with erasers

Theater (note: not all HS students are in Theater):

- 2 inch 3 ring binder
- 50 page protectors
- 2 scripts for individual play reports-(not for 1st day)

11th and 12th Grade

General Supplies for all classes:

- 1 or 2 large binders for all classes (student choice: either 1 for all 8 classes or 2, one for A day classes and one for B day classes)
- tab dividers (2 packages, 3 packs if taking French)
- Pencil(s)
- Pen(s) (blue or black)
- Highlighter(s)
- Dry erase marker(s)
- Soft pencil case
- Scotch tape
- Post-it notes
- Page protectors (pack of 50)
- Planner (optional, but recommended)
- Earbuds (always keep in backpack)

Items to Bring and Leave in 1st Period Classroom

- 2 reams of copy paper
- 2 boxes of tissues

Class-specific Supplies

French

- 1 extra pack tab dividers

DP Math, Math Studies, and TOK

- AAA batteries (pack of 4)
- Two notebook options. Either:
 - 5-subject plastic cover college ruled spiral (Math & TOK, students to keep on hand at all times), or
 - 3-subject plastic cover college ruled spiral for Math plus composition book for TOK (to keep on hand at all times)

DP Biology

- 2 Composition books, any line format, graph recommended

DP Chemistry

- 2 Composition books, any line format
- Rubber Gloves (old gloves from DP Y1 or MYP Chemistry are fine)

DP Physics

- 1 Composition book, any line format but grid recommended 100 sheets, 200 pages needed

DP Visual Arts (note: not all HS students are in Art):

- Hardcover sketchbook 8 1/2 x11
- Drawing/shading pencil set with erasers

DP Theater (note: not all HS students are in Theater):

- 2 inch 3 ring binder (may use one from a previous year if in good shape.)
- page protectors (1 pack)
- 4 scripts for individual play reports-(not for 1st day)

Physics (elective 10th-12th grade)

- 1 composition book, any line format, grid recommended, 100 sheets, 200 pages

Computer Science (elective 9th-12th grade)

- 1 composition book, any line format 100 sheets, 200 pages
