- MUST submit a BHSS website campaign post (details on next page)
- MUST submit a poster to be displayed on the BHSS website (details on next page)
- MUST respond within 48 hours to student questions sent to them by the Elections Coordinators
- MUST film a BHSS Elections interview video (details on next page)
- MAY create a campaign Facebook and/or Instagram page(s) (details on next page)
- MAY engage in word-of-mouth campaigning of any form (in-person, on- and off- campus, and through electronic communication services) should they wish

## NOTE: You only need to submit the first page of this nomination package.

Campaigning items for submission (N.B. all items except the campaign Facebook and/or Instagram page(s) are mandatory; failure to submit required items by the indicated deadline may result in disqualification):

- One (1) message about the candidate and his or her campaign, to be posted on the BHSS website
  - o Your message may contain no more than one picture and must be no longer than 250 words.
  - o Your message must be submitted via email to the Elections Coordinators (bhssele@mcmaster.ca) no later than 5:00 PM on September 23, 2025
- One (1) 8.5' x 11' poster about the candidate and his or her campaign, to be displayed on the BHSS website after approval by the Elections Coordinators
  - o Your poster may contain no more than one picture (picture must be of candidate) and no more than 250 words
  - o Your poster must be submitted via email to the Elections Coordinators (bhssele@mcmaster.ca)no later than **5:00 PM on September 23, 2025**
- One (1) campaign Facebook and/or Instagram page(s)
  - o Candidates must make both Elections Coordinators and the BHSS Chair admins on their Facebook page
    - Shall candidates make an Instagram page, they *must connect* it with their Facebook page (shall they decide to make one)
  - o Candidates must keep their page(s) private after their creation (all pages will be made public at the same time by the Elections Coordinators)
    - Instagram pages *must* remain deactivated until when campaigning opens; candidates will have full control of the Instagram pages.
  - o Candidates *are* permitted to invite others to "like" their campaign Facebook page or "follow" students from their Instagram page, or have people invite others to do so on their behalf
  - o Candidates *are* permitted to share their page(s) in any way they wish (e.g. on their own personal timeline), or have others do so on their behalf
    - Candidates are not permitted to share their page(s) in the Official BHSc Facebook Class Groups (the Elections Coordinators will post links to the campaign pages in these groups)
    - Candidates must have the BHSS Facebook page linked in the description section of their Facebook page
    - Candidates *must* have the BHSS Instagram page linked in the bio of their Instagram page
      - Note: third-party link organizers are allowed to include multiple links (i.e. Linktree)
    - If sharing their campaign Facebook page, the candidate *must* include a link to the BHSS Facebook page alongside the link to their campaign Facebook page in their post
    - If sharing their campaign Instagram page, the candidate *must* tag the BHSS Instagram page in said post/story
  - o Candidates must have their pages prepared to be made public (i.e. with both Elections



Coordinators and the BHSS Chair as admins) by **5:00 PM on September 23, 2025**, if they wish to have a campaign Facebook and/or Instagram page

- The campaign Facebook and/or Instagram page(s) do not have to be "finished" at this time, and can be modified as the candidates wishes after the deadline and throughout the election
- o Candidates may post whatever they wish on their page, in any medium (e.g. text, pictures, videos, infographics, livestream Q&As).
- o Candidates may post however often as they wish on their page(s)
- o Candidates may reply to messages sent to their campaign page(s)
- One (1) campaign video, filmed by each candidate (45 seconds to present a prepared speech; 35 seconds to respond to "Year reps and their committees often work to create a strong sense of community within thier respective cohorts. How would you go about building this community among first-year students given the diversity in the program?")
  - o Videos *must* be filmed in front of a plain background. Candidates *may not* use any props, sounds, or distracting text in their films.
  - o Films will be due for submission by 5:00 PM on September 27, 2025
  - o Films will be submitted to the Elections Coordinators via email (more details to be emailed)
- Answers to questions asked by BHSS General Members, processed and sent to the candidates by the Elections Coordinators
  - o Students will have the opportunity to submit anonymous questions for candidates by emailing bhssele@mcmaster.com; these questions (if any) will be sent to the applicable candidates within 48 hours of the Coordinators receiving them
  - o Candidates *must* respond to the Coordinators (via email) **within 48 hours of receiving a question** answers will be posted publicly, and may be as brief/long as the candidates wishes
