Unit 3 Lesson 2



Aim: Students will learn to identify and name different family members using listening and coloring.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Printed photos or images of family members (mother, father, brother, sister, baby, grandmother, grandfather) *attached
- Crayons
- AK audio track

Tip: Use a warm and calm tone to guide students through the activities. Repeat instructions for clarity and ensure each child gets individual attention during coloring.

Engage:

Arrange the printed photos of family members (e.g., mother, father, baby, grandmother, grandfather) on a table or display them in a row where all students can see.

Show the photos to the students and name each family member together. Ask the students to close their eyes while you remove one photo. When they open their eyes, ask: *"Who is missing?"*

Once they identify the missing person, ask them to find and point to the corresponding illustration in their book. Repeat the activity, rotating roles so students can take turns removing and identifying photos.

Explore & Practice:

With the Book

Show the book page and explain the task.

Use clear instructions and gestures: *"Listen to me and point to the family member I say. This is the father. Can you find the father?"* Use varied tones to make the instructions engaging and repeat as needed.

Colouring Activity

Provide crayons or colored pencils. Review colours.

Tell students they will listen for instructions to colour the frames on the page.

Play the audio track and monitor to check that students are doing the activity in the right way. Offer support as needed.

Closing:

Gather the children in a circle and invite them to share their colored family member pictures with the group.

End the lesson with a goodbye song, such as "Goodbye, Family," where each child can wave goodbye to a family member in their picture.

Goodbye, Family (to the tune of *Twinkle, Twinkle*)

♪ Goodbye, Mommy,
Goodbye, Dad,
Goodbye, sister,
Don't be sad.
Goodbye, brother,
See you soon,
We'll play again
This afternoon!
Goodbye, Family,
Wave and smile—
I'll be back
In just a while! ♪
