Vision for 2027

Goal:

Our goal is to become a church that prays together, obeys the scriptures, shares life together, and regularly gathers around the table in communion.

Devotion - rooted in Acts 2:42

We want to be a church fully devoted to Jesus:

- Devoted to prayer before worldly noise
- Devoted to Scripture before secular cultural influences
- Devoted to community before isolation
- Devoted to communion before consumerism

Our culture constantly disciplines people into radical independence and individualism. But the Kingdom of God forms people into a family. We need God, and we need one another.

In 2027, we want to reject isolated Christianity and rediscover biblical community marked by humility, presence, prayer, generosity, healing, and shared meals.
