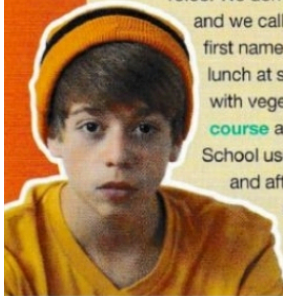

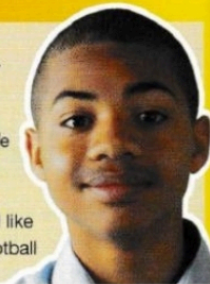
B Diego - Mexico
