

## Panther Band Boosters Meeting

**Meeting Date: 10/21/20/25 6:00 pm- BHS Band Hall**

Meeting Opening with:

### **A. Secretary's Report- Deidra Pullin:**

- **September meeting minutes:** a copy was distributed to all in attendance. Motion made by Nikki Washburn to approve Secretary's report and seconded by Heather Powers; the motion passed unanimously.
- **BHS Band website:** website was discussed and is currently being updated to include meeting minutes once approved, band updates, Amazon list, and more. Coach Willis has a class that will update the website with information provided by the secretary (Deidra Pullin).

### **B. Treasurer's Report- Jillian Duncan:**

- **Previous Balance (last meeting-09/16/25): \$5,814.26**
- **Current Balance as of 10/21/2025:** \$8,684.46
- ***Known upcoming expenses:***
- **\$500 scholarship** to be pd out for Suzie Flyger
- **Reimburse band supplies** (\$2,637.84) to the Bells Panther Band (check issue Sept/25)
- Band Activity fund will reimburse for **Tops & Sash (\$879.43)** that were recently purchased by Boosters for performance.
- Cendera old bank account is completely closed down and was updated with new banking information.
- A meeting is scheduled for this coming Sunday 10/26/25 discuss taxes & IRS.
- Motion made by Nikki Washburn to approve treasurer's report and seconded by Matt Powers; the motion passed unanimously.

### **C. Current Band Needs- Carrie Burt:**

- **Music Stand Racks:** Mrs Sewell & Mr Cavender (band directors) are requesting 2 of these for band room. They are double-stacked to hold 40 stands, one for each band room. Heather Powers made a motion to approve up to \$1,500 for the stands, Jeremy Moore seconded it; the motion passed unanimously.
- **Snacks:** Water (8oz & 16 oz sizes) and sweet snacks are needed.
- **Portable power bank:** current one quit working and this is an urgent need for several instruments. Different options were discussed. Kim Sledd made a motion

to spend up to \$500, Jeremy Moore seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

#### **D. Fundraising Initiatives- Carrie Burt:**

- **Hunting Trip-** Guest speaker DJ is offering to raffle off a hunting trip for the fall and spring (possibly). He will provide camper, lease, stand, and food. The winner of the trip will need to 1.) have a hunting license, 2.) have taken a safety course unless they are a Veteran, 3.) must sign a waiver and agree to terms of the waiver. DJ will be onsite during the 3-day/2-night stay (Friday- Sunday) and it will be a guided hunt. Waiver will stay not guarantee a to kill a deer and signer accepts all liability. Tickets will be sold & drawing to be help on FB live Friday after Thanksgiving. The trip would be for the weekend after that. Kim Sledd made a motion to approve, Jeremy Moore seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.
- **Band Merchandise-**The current sale closes on Friday and shirts will be delivered next week. Last merchandise sale made almost \$500.
- **Christmas Cookie Boxes-** Kim Sledd explained cookies will be baked to include 6 cookies & 3 icings per box (red, green, white) and maybe sprinkles. A place will need to be designated for baking. The kitchen in the commons or local church would work. We can sell them for \$20 a box and could sell up to 100 boxes. Start selling 11/22 after the hunting trip raffle has ended and sell through 12/6. We can deliver boxes 12/20.
