

## **HTML BASIC** HTML Documents All HTML documents must start with a document type declaration: <!DOCTYPE html>. The HTML document itself begins with <a href="html">html</a> and ends with <a href="html">html</a>. The visible part of the HTML document is between <body> and </body>. <!DOCTYPE html> <html> <body> <h1>My First Heading</h1> My first paragraph. </body> </html> **HTML** Headings HTML headings are defined with the <h1> to <h6> tags. <h1> defines the most important heading. <h6> defines the least important heading: <h1>This is heading 1</h1> <h2>This is heading 2</h2> <h3>This is heading 3</h3> **HTML Paragraphs** HTML paragraphs are defined with the tag: This is a paragraph. This is another paragraph. HTML Links HTML links are defined with the <a> tag: <a href="https://www.w3schools.com">This is a link</a> **HTML** Images
