PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Head of School Student Ambassador team is a select group of students responsible for representing Silverdale Baptist Academy. **The mission of Student Ambassadors is to share the Silverdale experience with prospective and current students, their families, and community members.** Student Ambassadors will be the face of the Academy and are selected for their demonstration of leadership, campus involvement, academic achievement, and Seahawk pride. Student Ambassadors serve as special event assistants representing the student and broader communities. Special events, new student orientation, hosting campus VIPs, etc. constitute examples of special events in which the student ambassadors should engage.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Bearing in mind that Student Ambassadors serve as an essential component to Silverdale's Public Relations effort, several responsibilities are placed on the Student Ambassador.

Responsibilities:

- Positively represent the Silverdale student body as Shadow Host
- Act as an ambassador from the student body to prospective students and families at above mentioned events
- Assist in the recruitment of future Student Ambassadors

- Willingness to develop and improve marketing and communication skills
- A sincere desire to help Silverdale foster the school's positive reputation

To remain an active Student Ambassador you must attend ALL meetings and 1 training session, actively participate in volunteer offerings, and conduct ALL ambassador actions in a professional manner. Failure to do so could result in immediate disqualification of position by the Office of the Head of School and/or Development staff.
