Looking for an affordable opportunity to buy a simple, decent home? The selection process:

- 1. To be considered for a Habitat home, you must attend one of our community meetings at which we explain the process from application to homeownership. The only time you can request an application is at one of these meetings. We have no meetings scheduled at this time. When we start the selection process again, we will announce the meetings on this website. If you would like to be notified when these meetings will be held, please send an e-mail to inquiry@habitattuolumne.org.
- 2. After you have attended one of our meetings and requested an application, you will have thirty days to complete the application and provide all requested documentation including but not limited to tax returns, W-2's, verification of employment, bank statements, and copies of utility bills.
- 3. Application and ALL paperwork must be returned in person on assigned dates to Habitat staff and volunteers. Any incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 4. You then wait to hear from us:

If you don't qualify, you'll receive a notification letter.

If you do qualify, you will be notified that your application is still under review.

A short list of qualified applicants will receive phone calls to schedule home visits.

5. The Family Selection Committee performs the following tasks:

Reviews submitted applications in detail

Checks references

Runs credit check

Makes home visits

6. The Board of Directors makes the final selection based on recommendations from the Family Selection Committee.
