### Course Information

# **Course Description**

Science 7 is interdisciplinary in nature; however, much of the content focuses on organisms and the environment.

Students use scientific inquiry methods during investigations as they study the following topics: the flow of matter and energy through systems, the impact of natural events and human activity on ecosystems, the complementary nature of structures and functions in organisms, and that genetic material found in the cells determines traits.

**Note for Honors:** The course is designed to equip students with conceptual understanding and critical thinking needed in preparation for high school Advanced Placement courses.

## Class Materials

You will need access to a Chromebook for class every day as well as a pen/pencil to write with. You are responsible for updating your digital notebook over the course of the year. You may also need colored pencils and headphones but will be provided with a set if you forget them or did not buy a set as part of your supply list.

### Late Work

You will have ONE class day to submit late work for a maximum grade of 70. For example, if something is due on an A-day Monday, you may turn in the assignment on A-day Wednesday (the next class) for a maximum of a 70. If the assignment is not turned in after two class days, the assignment will be a maximum grade of a 50. After 2 classes, work will no longer be taken and will be a zero in Skyward.
