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**ABSTRACT**

An abstract should accompany each manuscript, Written concisely and factually, including an introductory statement of the problem, purpose, research methods, findings and theoretical implications. The length of the abstract ranges from 150-200 words in one paragraph. Avoid the use of abbreviations or quotations.

**Keyword:** Write 3-5 words or phrases, and separate them using commas



## **A. Introduction**

It should contain the background, research objectives of the article, previous similar studies, to justify the novelty of the article/research conducted (there should be references to journals in the last ten years); some literature that serves as a theoretical basis; and research methods used;

Articles are written using standard English with a length of between 5000 and 8000 words, or about 15-20 pages, including figures, graphs, and tables (if any), on A4 paper size (21 x 29.7 cm), with margin distance (left 3 cm, right 3 cm, top 3 cm, bottom 3 cm), using Cambria font type (12 pt), 1.15 space, and in Microsoft Word format (.doc/.docx).

## **B. Result and Discussion 1**

The result and discussion section should be titled a Chapter, a statement of the research objectives. You may use subtitles in the discussion according to the research indicators or the needs of the discussion. The discussion may include figures and tables, but the author must explain the purpose of the figures and tables and include the source of the figures and tables. Included in the discussion are; Theoretical/Conceptual Framework, Findings (conditional findings), The position of the findings (strengthen/refute/new position).

## **C. Result and Discussion 2, etc**

The results and discussion sections can be written in more than one chapter, depending on the number of research objectives the author wants to explain.

## **D. Conclusion**

Presented in short, concise, and clear paragraphs based on the discussion and suggested pathways for further research (include: Findings, theoretical implications, limitations and recommendations).

## **References**

Journal sources from the last ten years are recommended. Provide a list of references alphabetically and prepared following the American Psychological Journal Referencing Style (7th Edition). All references must be cited in the text, and all in-text citations must be listed in the reference list. A DOI for each reference should be provided if available. It is recommended that authors use a reference manager application such as Mendeley or Zotero.
