

Dual Credit/Online College Classes

Dual Credit Classes:

Central City offers several dual credit hour classes taught by CCHS teachers. Students can receive high school and college credit through Central Community College or the University of Nebraska-Kearney. Please check the Course Catalog, which is continually updated.

If a student wishes to take the class for credit, the student/family is responsible for the cost of the class. If they qualify, students can apply for the ACE scholarship.

Online Classes:

Students can also take an independent online course through Central Community College. The student will be provided a period within their schedule to work on the course; however, a teacher will not be assigned to assist the student. It will be the sole responsibility of the student to complete the online course and contact the instructor as needed for additional support.

The student/family is responsible for the cost of the class. If they qualify, students can apply for the ACE scholarship (see below).

Determining Which Classes to Take:

The [Transfer Nebraska](#) website might help you determine which college classes to take. It will also show how your dual/online classes may transfer to other postsecondary institutions. Of course, they will have the most accurate information when you go for college admissions appointments. It is highly suggested that students talk directly with their college advisor to make the best choices.

College Transcripts:

To transfer your college credit hours to another college, complete the transcript request form from the college where you took the class. CCHS cannot provide

these transcripts, as they belong to the student and the college. CCHS does not keep a record of a student's college coursework.
