Library – Librarian from Kildare Town library is meeting with PA Committee Member & KTCS English teacher Tuesday, Oct 15th to discuss converting the school library into a fully functioning library for students. Parents help on this is appreciated. A parent has a contact in Gill publishers and offered help with this project, especially around access to exam papers. Garda vetting will be needed for any Parents who wish to help with the running of the Library. This will need to be applied for through the school.

ASD Unit – Another project for this year to kit out the unit for the benefit of students who use the unit. Requested parental assistance/involvement on this too.

Communications - KTCS Website (PA Page), iClass app, Email, Facebook, Twitter & LinkedIn – all the above methods of communication were discussed and information on these platforms will be taken from the KTCS website. PA page to be updated too. Calendars across all platforms will be synchronised so parents are aware of all events that are taking place. Good practice in all these matters was discussed also, acceptable user policy to be developed & all users to agree to uphold this policy.
