3. Exceptions

To both teacher and student: *“When is this happening a bit already—in your classroom, other classrooms, and situations at school or even outside school?”* Write down the answers below:

4. Strategy development

To both teacher and student: *“Based on what you have both said today, we would like to read back what you have told us”* [read the exceptions in item 3] *“and together with you come up with a plan for* [a day, for a child; a week, for an adolescent].”



5. Scale

To teacher and student: *“On a scale of 1 to 10, with a 10 being that things are just like you want them to be and a 1 meaning that things are not working, where were you when you came in today? Where would you like to be in [specified time]?”*

To both teacher and student: *“To end our conversation, we are interested in what was helpful for you today.”*
