Despite announcing it at last month’s Group Conscience meeting and having the survey mentioned in the pre-meeting announcements for two weeks, and publicizing it in the Friends of North Hall Facebook group, we had only 13 responses. GSR summarized the survey results in a content analysis and shared it with those who had requested an email. The content analysis can be found on the public Google Drive in the Group Conscience folder: 2024_04 Content Analysis on Founders’ Writings Survey.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ There were strong opinions both in support of revisions to the Founders’ writings as well as for preservation of the original text.</li><li>○ A majority of respondents expressed support for some changes to the AA founders’ writings for inclusivity and representation, and for accessibility and clarity. This was by no means a unanimous opinion.</li></ul></li><li>● Therefore, GSR shared with Matthew L., our CNIA 07 delegate to the General Service Conference via email:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Our general support for the development of the pamphlets</li><li>○ The content analysis of the limited survey on the AA founders’ writings</li><li>○ Our experience in 2021 with the proposal that came before the Group Conscience to change the language in How It Works and More About Alcoholism readings at the beginning of meetings for our fellowship to make the language gender inclusive. I shared that it had been a difficult topic for our fellowship, and when it came to a vote, a majority were in favor but our fellowship had agreed to a substantial</li></ul></li></ul>
