'Sustainable Travel Incentive' Terms and Conditions

Up to 10% Cash Back when travelling by sustainable transport

1. If travelling by public transport from your home address, we will contribute towards your travel tickets, up to a maximum limited by either:
 - 1.1. 10% of your booking fee with us
 - 1.2. £30
 - 1.3. The cost of your travel tickets from your home address
2. If travelling by self-propelled transport (cycle touring, long distance backpacking or similar) we will give you 10% of your booking fee with us, up to a maximum of £30
3. You must tell us that you want to claim the 'Sustainable Travel Incentive' when making your booking with us.
4. The amount of cash back should be agreed before the day of the event by informing us of your travel plans and costs as necessary.
5. Cash Back is given to you at the time your booked event takes place
6. Sustainable transport types and proof required
 - 6.1. Trains, coaches or buses

Tickets must be presented to us before receiving cash back

Tickets must show the journey start and end points, the price paid and a unique reference number or payment reference
 - 6.2. Cycle touring, Long distance backpacking

Evidence in some way, such as informing us of your trip plans or if blogging send us a link to follow your trip
7. Do e-bikes count?
 - 7.1. Yes, cycle touring on an e-bike qualifies you for the sustainable transport cash back
 - 7.2. I'm a huge e-bike fan. When an elderly lady cycled past me riding an e-bike up the Furka Pass in Switzerland with a huge grin on her face, it made me smile too!
