

REMEMBER: File, Make A Copy

Planning and Prewriting: As a Trio, discuss and complete the answers to the following questions - change the text color to make it easier for me to see your answers

- Which characters had a strong response to the cultural collision? Which one will you choose?
- What was this character's sense of identity before encountering the new influence?
- What was this character's response to the new influence? What did he/she do/think/say; how did he/she interact with others; how did his/her role and/or perspective shift?
- What were the consequences of this character's response and his/her willingness or unwillingness to change?
- What statement about culture is the author making through this character, and how can you include this in your essay?
- What textual support can you find for your section of the essay?

Introduction

Must include: Hook, TAG (Title, Author, Genre), One of the Essential Questions from the 1-10 list, Restatement of the assignment

Body Paragraphs

(You will need, at least, three)

Sentence 1- Topic Sentence

EX: Communication between canines and their owner is all about dominance.

Sentence 2- Example 1

Ex: "Canines have an innate trait to follow someone who shows them structure and discipline" (Milan).

Sentence 3- Explain Ex 1

Ex: Due to this fact, dogs will listen to their owners if the owner can establish the dominant role in the relationship. This is the first step in training and effective communication between dog and owner

Sentence 4- Example 2

EX: "When an owner acts calm and assertive lets the canine know that the owner is the boss and they should feel at ease" (Milan).

Sentence 5- Explain Ex 2

EX: If the owner wants their dog to feel comfortable and confident, the owner needs to act that way themselves.

Sentence 6- Continue Citing Facts and Explaining...

Sentence 7- Transition

Ex: Getting the dog to listen to and respect the owner is the first step in training, next comes training specific behaviors.
