

ALL DEGREES REQUIRE 127 CREDITS TO GRADUATE





GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (AT LEAST 30 CREDITS)

- First-Year Seminar or Advanced-Entry Seminar (4 credits)
- Languages and Cultures (through the 3rd semester of language proficiency)
- Social Justice (at least 3 credits)
- Fitness and Recreational Activity (FRA) (2 credits)
- Exploration and Breadth (each at least 3 credits)

6 courses are required; one from each of the 4 areas above plus 2 courses from 2 different areas.

Courses must be outside of major discipline

- o Humanities
- o Natural Sciences
- o Social Sciences
- o Fine Arts

MAJOR (AT LEAST 30 CREDITS)

- BSEd degree requires at least 34 credits
- BM and BFA degrees credits vary

MINOR (NOT REQUIRED, AT LEAST 18 CREDITS)

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED COURSES FOR BS DEGREES

- Biology 50-123/121 or 50-133/131 (4 credits)
- Chemistry 51-103/101 (4 credits)
- Mathematics 52-154 (4 credits)
- Physics 53-154 (4 credits)
- 2 approved courses from different Natural Science disciplines to complete year-long sequence (specified by major) (8 credits)
- At least 2 additional course requirements in Natural Science or Psychology (specified by major) (credits vary)
