

The University of Minnesota Health CRU is located in the Philips Wangensteen Building, which is adjacent to the University of Minnesota Medical Center. The facilities are approximately 8,000 assignable square feet and include patient exam rooms, an interview/consult room, a negative airflow room, procedure rooms, infusion rooms, and an exercise room. The exam rooms are able to support overnight study visits. Support areas include: the reception and waiting area, a secure file room, a nursing station, a small patient nutrition area, specimen processing and computer support area. The CRU provides expert nurses and general supplies and equipment necessary to perform quality clinical research studies.
