

## Professional Development Opportunity – Mapping your desired future.

This three-day interactive learning experience will train you to be competent and confident PATH and MAPS facilitators. PATH and MAPS are graphic facilitation tools for 'big picture', goal-oriented planning for individuals or groups. Each tool involves a co-facilitated process to develop a comprehensive plan in pictorial form that explores a desired future and identifies action steps to achieve positive and possible outcomes.

The training teaches on, and aligns with, the Enabling Good Lives principles [Enabling Good Lives principles](#). The three-day workshop includes:

- Introduction to graphic facilitation techniques
- Introduction to the philosophy of PATH and MAPS
- Demonstration of PATH or MAPS
- Practice of facilitation of PATH and MAPS (each participant will have an experience of being a PATHfinder or MAPmaker, a process facilitator and a graphic facilitator)
- Overview of other tools using graphic facilitation techniques
- Review and debrief of learning.

The workshop will take place in Nelson from December 4th to 6th, 2024. The cost is approximately \$1600 per participant, which includes workbooks, lunch, and refreshments each day.

This course is targeted at those working with young people, particularly those who work with young people who have disabilities or learning needs. To run a bespoke programme, we need a minimum of 10 participants.
