- ➤ NETLAB+ Update -A survey was sent out on 5/20/25-Due May 28, 2025
 - Message:At the May 2nd Program Recommendation meeting, Theresa Milan communicated that Los Rios can no longer host Netlabs after June of 30, 2026. During the meeting, the estimated cost incurred by Los Rios was \$30,000. Our voting members decided to conduct a contract change with Los Rios CCD to pull back the remaining amount (approximated at \$170,000) and give equal amounts to each college. After our Program Recommendation meeting, Los Rios determined that their total cost for Netlabs is \$38,503.44. Here is that breakdown:

 - VE2-Maintenance-\$5,995.00

Some of the COE data showed low or negative growth for 2023-2028. The other concern
is the number of students some of these programs are supporting. Instructionally we
must be able to afford to teach these courses and that requires higher numbers of
students per course. Some of the initial goals were low, but hopefully the program
expansion will increase enrollments.

Comments:

- I believe Sierra's Advanced Manu, Mech Comp Aided Design & Drafting degrees, and Mech Drafting Specialist cert are just prog modification. The Program Requirements state, "Select 6-9 units from the electives list..." Why would anyone opt to take more units (9) if they can finish the degree with 6 units? Is the range of units due to the variable units for the internship? However, even the internship course (ADVM 0028) is an elective. Same with the Mech Comp program.
- Butte College-Elec Trainee Cert-I suspect that ET 201 is the prereq to ET 202, and ET 202 is the prereq to ET 203, etc. However, under the program requirements, it shows that all these courses will be taken in semester 1. That's 16 units for semester 1 and 16 units for semester 2. Are these courses taught in a compressed schedule (ie., 4 units in 4 weeks)? It just seems a lot of hours/demand for the students each semester.

- "BAR 100 is a program prerequisite (2 units) for both the AS and certificate in Barbering. I understand the program's desire to ensure that students know the field/career they are applying to. If students decide not to apply or are not selected for the BAR program, the 2 units would only count as electives and add to their total units. One of Vision 2030's goals is to reduce the average number of units for students pursuing an associate degree. Was there any discussion on how this may affect the students?
- The AS and certificate note, ""Procedures: On the first day of BAR 100, students will designate a preference for one of the course offerings options listed below. If too many students select one of the options, a lottery will be

held to fill the class. Students who are not selected will be able to register for their second preference. This process will continue until all courses have been filled."" There was no mention of what the course offerings are or if they are the courses that are required for the BAR program. It is also unclear how students are selected for the BAR program or if all students will be automatically accepted to the BAR program if they earn a ""C"" in BAR 100."

 - R: Mark Klever-traditional route or the competency based education route, hourly wages are going to be the same. Entry level wage is going to be below the living wage. How they approach it.

Comments:

- Shasta-ECE in the Program Requirements, it states, "All certificate requirements must be completed with a B grade (80%) or better." Is the student allowed to repeat a course if they got a C? Will that throw them off the program course offering sequence if they have to repeat a course (to improve their grade to meet the requirement)?
 - R: Angela Cordell-faculty felt that health and nutrition came too late in the curriculum. They wanted to move it up in the timeline of when it is delivered, and that's what bumped us into a space where we needed to send this back for review.
 - Work with students until they get a B so CBE doesn't have a specific timeline associated with it in the same way that our non Cbe courses do. And so what it means is that a student will be considered competent and ready to step into the next course when they receive that 80% or better, and the faculty are there to support them in that?
 - Cv is not working for them, then we have a plan to move them back into a traditional education pathway
