The target customers encompass a broad age range, with a particular focus on individuals aged 18-44 who frequently (4-6 times/year), occasionally (1-3 times/year) or rarely (once a year) travel internationally. The problem we are addressing revolves around the myriad difficulties encountered during international travel, especially managing visa and document requirements, flight check-ins and efficiently navigating airports.

The world is becoming increasingly interconnected leading to the demand for international travel. According to AAA booking data, international travel is up more than 200% compared to 2022. The World Travel and Tourism Council in December 2017 identified that affluence, demographic shifts, convenience, and awareness are among the major drivers in the increase in global tourism. Due to these factors, the need for ease of travel to overcome the barriers of frustration and unwanted expense is also in demand.

However, the existing tools and resources for travelers often fall short in addressing their needs effectively. With technological advancements and the growing reliance on mobile apps make this an opportune moment to provide an all-inclusive travel app to enhance the travel experience.

During the user research, 95% of the participants confirmed the existence of these challenges and the need for an app that will cater to their needs. 70% of the travelers interviewed faced challenges in managing visa and document requirements for multiple destinations, flight check-ins and schedules. 60% also confirmed they had sought expert assistance in the visa applications, form reviews, and travel planning in the past.

As of now, there is no effective solution that has addressed passport and visa completeness related difficulties, flight schedules and airport navigation, and expert advice all in one place. Current tools and resources for travelers often fall short in addressing their needs. The world is becoming increasingly interconnected, leading to more international travel. Technology and mobile app usage have become integral in planning and executing trips, making this the perfect moment to introduce a comprehensive travel app. The insights from the research confirmed the existence of these issues, making it evident that addressing them is essential for enhancing the travel experience.

Scenario #2: Airport Navigation Scenario:

- Users can input their airport and departure gate information.
- The app provides an interactive map with clear directions to the check-in counter and gate.
- Estimated walk times are accurate and updated in real-time.
- The map includes prominent landmarks and amenities.
- The feature is user-tested to ensure ease of use and efficiency.
- Users consistently report that the app helps them find their check-in counter and gate easily, reducing the risk of missing flights.

Scenario #3: Flight Check-In Scenario:

- Users can set up customizable flight check-in reminders.
- Reminders are sent through push notifications and email.
- Reminders are sent at the times specified by the user.
- The feature integrates with flight booking platforms to fetch relevant flight details.
- The feature is user-tested to ensure timely and reliable reminders.
- Users report that they receive reminders as scheduled and find them helpful in arriving at the airport on time.

Scenario #4: Connecting Flight Scenario:

- The app provides real-time flight tracking.
- Users receive updates on their connecting flight status, including delays or gate changes.
- In case of missed connections, the app offers step-by-step guidance on what to do and where to go.
- The guidance includes information on rebooking, security checks, and transportation options.
- The feature is user-tested to ensure clarity and usefulness.
- Users report reduced stress and confusion when facing delayed connections.

Scenario #5: Expert Assistance Scenario:

- Users can access a section of the app for expert assistance.
- The app provides access to subject matter experts who can assist with visa applications, form reviews, and reservations.
- Users can submit their queries and receive timely responses.
- Consultations with experts are available on-demand.
- The feature is user-tested to ensure ease of access and responsiveness.
- Users report satisfaction with the quality and convenience of expert assistance.
