### 2. Meal Service Program Assessment (17 min)

- Objective: Reflect and iterate on current meal service program across all SPS schools (not state specific)
- Discussion:
  - What's going well?
    - Michelle L: Happy with the food at SPS, having menu and 3-4 options usually daughter finds something that she likes. Agrees with the challenge of nutrition over taste. My daughter likes pasta, breaded chicken sandwich, chicken noodle soup, hamburgers, corn dogs
    - Daira (Everest): Love the communication between provider and campuses

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- Yesenia + Lourdes (Atlas): Important to value student input
  - Roly (K2 student): salads are very popular
  - Caroline: individually wrapped fruit, apple slices popular. Try new items: chicken calzone was added this year and its super popular
  - Uriel: flexibility of lunchmaster, being able to cancel orders, responsive communication, great drivers
  - Xochil: Vegetarian options are helpful, field trip lunches
  - Cata: Easy ordering, adjusting schedule
  - Olson: daily cereal option allows students who arrive late to get breakfast that does not to be heated
  - What could be improved?
    - Michelle: Some days there are fewer options, at least three options is best. Not as good when they serve the same item multiple days in a row. We should do a survey to see what students like.
    - Tosh D: Taste is the main reason students give for not eating school lunch
    - Anaya: Inconsistencies (sometimes biscuits get swapped out for general wheat buns) impact students, quality issues (bad fruit)
    - Caroline: We used to have 4 options, now only 3. Would also be nice to know cereal options - some days its the same 3 days in a row
    - Lizbeth: students are tired of pizza; we need more variety
    - Xochil: Students request almond milk and oat milk, variety would be helpful
    - Yesenia + Lourdes (Atlas): Last year we were provided a full list of options and I got to make selections of what was served for lunch each day. It improved our participation but we have not been able to do that this year. Our menu is also too cyclical - feels like each week students are eating the same meals on the same days.

    - Goal from Spring 2022: Collect feedback from students on the entrees that they like and don't like
      - We need to create a student survey
        - Volunteers for survey CA: Summit K2
      - It would also be great to create a parent/caregiver survey

    - What are glows and grows when it comes to student health and nutrition?

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- Uriel: Summit Prep gets caregiver donations for chewy bars/nutrigrain bars. Strict guidelines. Provided for students who need to take medication.
  - Daira: Everest donations for same reason and during testing season
  - Tosh: Summit K2 HS keeps leftover table available for students (cereals, extra lunches)
  - Olson: K2 HS chose to have enrichment / intervention block immediately after lunch allowing longer movement break for students opting into enrichment classes like rugby, flag football, martial arts, girls lacrosse, etc
  - Physical activity options during Expeditions
  - Staff vs. students games during lunch time
  - What would you like to see insofar as communication from the school, or the school doing?
    - Anaya: access to the meal calendar / schedule on our website more in advance
  - Spring 2022 Goal: Build connections with local organizations to promote physical activity and safe routes to school
    - Have we done this? What more can we do?
      - Olympus: access to “uber” and other transportation options when students’ neighborhoods are impacted by violence/gun violence
      - K2 HS: many students participate in bus pass program for ACT transit
      - Everest: SamTrans passes
