

Adding new projects, categories and services


You can see all your projects there:




You can see, edit or remove all your projects. You can see the two flags on the screenshot below: Canadian (en language) and French (fr language). If you can see the checkbox near the Canadian flag, it means that it's the post in English. In order to add/edit the same post in French, you need to click on the icon with pensil near the checkbox. And exactly the same way for French variants.




In order to add the new project, you need to press here (the screenshot below):




Then you can change the language and all the needest fields




After finishing, you need to press publish and the project will appear on your website.




2. Adding team members

At first, you need to press here:




If you press the "team" (not the "Add team member") you can see all your current team members in two languages, exactly like the projects.

One more thing. In order to place the "Trouble Publishing" button for HUGO LOÏS, I've added these two fields:




If you need to add another button for another team member, you can use them. But if you don't need to use the button, you can leave them empty.


3. Adding the words to the about

You can add the words here in the same way as other items (including the different languages):




You can add the title and link for each word:




Important thing! You need to add different links separately for English and France pages to link users to the page on the needest language.

Here is the link for France audio category and the word on the France language:




Here is the word in English with the link to English variant of category:




Go to the team tab.



Then choose the needest variant (en or fr) of the item


