

Dear Parents,

Year 3 will be given the opportunity to play Touch Football in Term 2. They will play in a competition against SCEGGS and Ascham. The competition will be aimed at preparing the girls for the introduction of IPSHA sport in Year 4 by learning the basic skills of the sport.

Please note: Year 3 Touch Football teams are not graded and students will have the opportunity to play every position during the season.

The Term 2 Touch Football competition will run on Saturdays in Term 2 and will be held at Steyne Park (William St, Double Bay)

Touch Football is a fast-paced, non-contact sport that emphasizes agility, teamwork, and strategy.

The competition will run for 7 weeks, starting on **2nd May**. The final day of the competition will be **20th June**

There will be no game on the King's birthday long weekend (Saturday, the 6 June)

Term 2 Touch Football training will be Fridays from 3.30pm - 4.45pm at Christison Park
Training sessions will start on April 24th

NOTE: (No training on Friday 29 May due to the Athletics carnival or Friday 5 June due to the long weekend)

In the event of wet weather please check Sundial for updates as a message will be posted by 7.15am if games are cancelled.

Please ensure that you have joined the Year 3 Touch Football page on Sundial and adjusted your notifications to receive all alerts. Instructions on how you can do this are in the Year 3 Sports Handbook which can be downloaded from the Year 3 class page, under the Sport tile.

In order to compete in the Term 2 Touch Football Competition, girls will need to purchase the Kambala black sports shorts and white polo shirt (same one as used in Term 1 Basketball). Please see the Junior School Sports Sundial Year 3 Touch Football page for further uniform information. All uniform pieces are available from Outfitters. When training, girls can wear their PE uniform (including House shirt). Please note that girls must bring to all sessions a water bottle and any necessary medication.
