Pennsylvania State Laws mandate responsible pet ownership, ensuring the safety and well-being of all residents, including our beloved pets. Here are the guidelines and provisions for pets at Mt. Maplewood Lake House:

State Laws:

- 1. All pets must remain on their owner's property or under their control at all times.
- 2. Mark Dogs must be properly licensed according to State, County, or Municipal laws.
- 3. Dogs must be on a leash under 8 feet in length and under the control of their handler on or off the property.

OPets are NOT ALLOWED in the lakes, streams or beaches to preserve the environment and safety of all guests. A \$100 FINE will be imposed for any violation, and the pet must leave immediately.

Fees and Regulations:

- III A fee of \$25 per night, per pet (up to 2 pets maximum) is applicable.
- • Dog-Friendly (sorry no meow). Dogs must be attended to at all times, inside and outside the property.
- Please refrain from bringing cats, puppies, or dogs that bark constantly as it would violate the noise policy.
- Please keep pets off furniture, or bring blankets or beds for your pet's comfort.
- Guests are responsible for cleaning up dog hair, food from the house, and poop from the yard and neighborhood.
- Any damage caused by pets will be deducted from the security deposit or billed separately. Guests are fully responsible and liable for their pet's behavior on the property, and the owner assumes no liability for any injuries or damage caused by pets.
- Excess dirt, pet hair, wet dog smell/stains, or other pet-related messes may result in an additional \$100 heavy cleaning charge.
- In the lease, unregistered pets are subject to immediate eviction, so please register your pet if you plan to bring one.
- ** A helpful TIP from our return guests: "Brush your dogs out a day or two before arrival to minimize hair during vacation!"

No refund is available for cancellations made within 14 days of check-in. *Non-Refundable Option is Not Refundable.

Early Departure: If the guest arrives and decides to leave early, the nights not spent are not refunded.


Why Have These Laws Been Created?

To better understand why many townships and cities have introduced stricter regulations for short-term rentals, here are some of the main reasons given:

- Age Restrictions (25-30): Similar to renting a car, age demographics play a significant role as they are statistically more likely to have incidents, which leads to higher insurance and rental rates, increased police calls, and community disturbances reported from neighbors.
- Noise Violations: Noise is the most common complaint. Many short-term rentals are located in HOA communities where full-time families and retirees live, making peace and quiet a priority.
- Trash and Parking Violations: These are among the top complaints, along with noise and lighting, disrupting community harmony and balance of life for families living, working, and retiring here.
- **Language of School Series** Increased Incidents: Community rangers and local police have reported higher rates of violations, which require court appearances, legal fees, and affect both guests and owners.
- Property Damage: Property managers experience higher rates of unreported damage, excessive wear and tear, or additional cleanup costs beyond normal costs. This impacts future rental rates and operational costs.

- Legal Risks: Real estate attorneys report that legal risks have increased significantly. Rental
 agreements and leases are now often required to inform guests of their obligations and
 responsibilities.
- Good Neighbor Pledge: We proudly follow the Good Neighbor policies set by the Poconos Association of Vacation Rental Owners (Poconos VRO), with a shared commitment from both owners and guests to put community and family first—so we can continue the privilege of welcoming families like yours into our home!
