There are two opportunities to participate: Please sign up to volunteer at the Labeling Party and to deliver to the school of your choice.

First, at our annual Labeling Party, we affix a bookplate on all the dictionaries so the students can write their name in their book next to Rotary's Four Way Test. For many students, this is the only or one of just a few books they own.

This year's Labeling Party takes place on September 25, 2018 at Green's Plumbing. Please join us for fun, pizza and beverages. You can sign up in person at the weekly lunch-time meeting. We will also provide an online/doodle list for you to consult.

Second, we deliver the dictionaries to the schools and classrooms during the last week in September and first week of October. We will make this very easy for you and your partner.

- We will have instructions for you to reach out to your school to determine the best time to deliver them.
- We will also give you a short script to use – LPS has asked us to make this efficient in a way that is respectful of teachers and instructional time.
