Meet Recaps

This week, we had an open meet at Dundee Crown followed by hosting the Bob Nihells Invite on Saturday. The Dundee Crown meet saw the distance runners and jumpers lead a PR parade, setting up the team for success on Saturday.

Saturday was by far our team's best performance of the year, capturing 2nd place on both Varsity and Fresh/Soph. The team took to heart the idea of performing well for our home meet, and it was a delight to see so many athletes stand up at the team meeting when we announced our PR's.

Tyler Michelini broke the 60 foot barrier in his shot put victory, making him the 4th thrower in Lake Park history to do so. Other event winners included our varsity 4x8 breaking 9 minutes, Charlie Michelini in the F/S shot put, and Josh Brown clearing 6'2 to win the varsity high jump.

Shield


- Dundee Crown Rodrigo Gonzalez for his 2 foot PR in the shot put and going up to #5 all-time in Lake Park history


