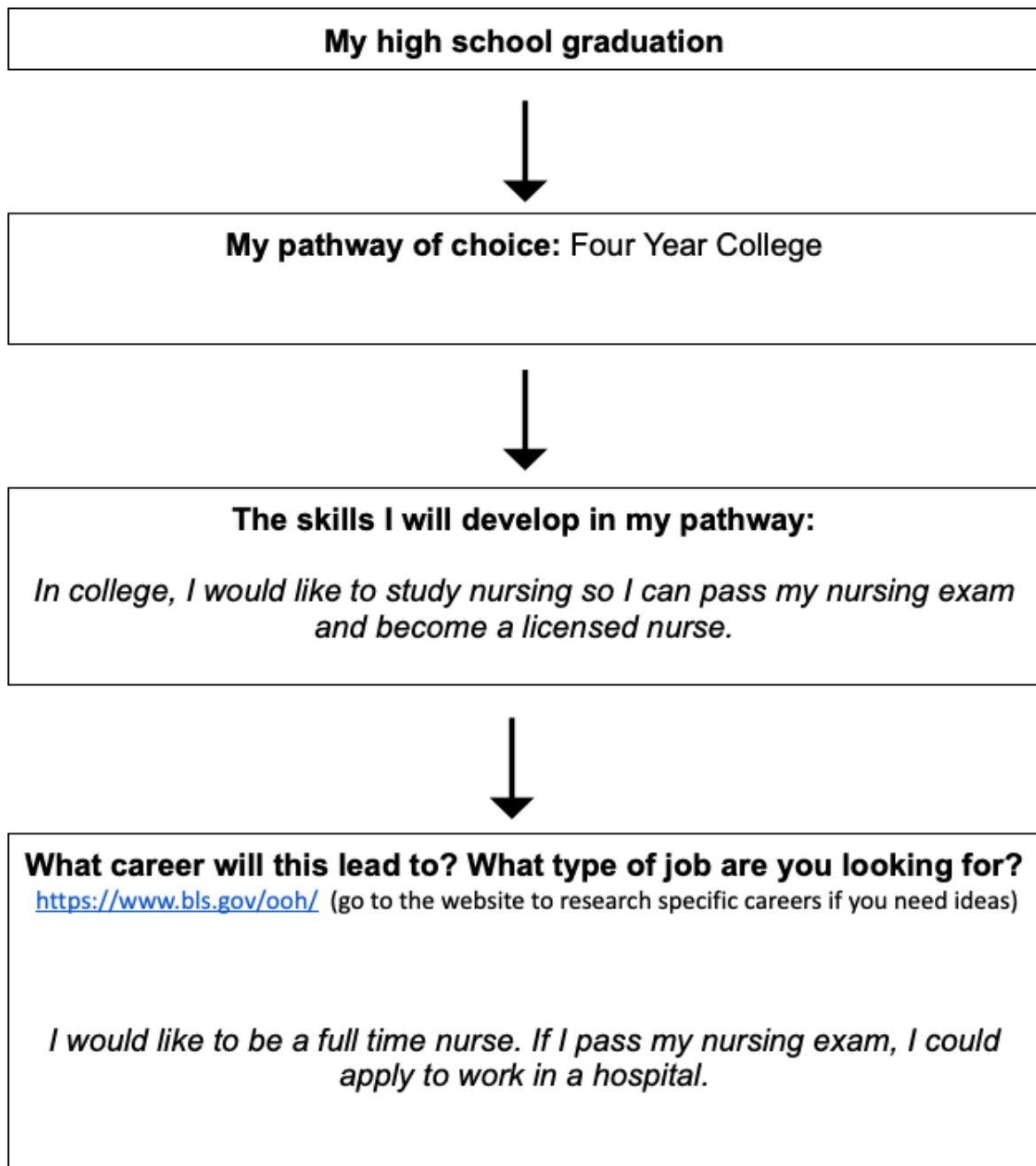

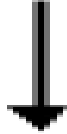
Career Mapping

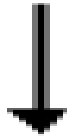
My Career Map

My high school graduation

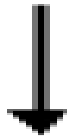


My pathway of choice:
