Blog Topics

Each post should be as the character that the students were assigned on the first day. Their responses will then be posted on their Biographical page.

- Day 1: Describe your home country, making sure to mention the leader and some of the problems and success your country is currently facing.
- Day 2: Explain how each of the four main causes is impacting your home country.
- Day 3: How would the start of the war impacted your character?
- Day 4: Explain which of the main causes had the least impact on your country.
- Day 5: Based on what you learned in the debate today, which county is responsible for starting the war based on the four causes?
- Day 6: Pick two of the technologies that were discussed in class today and as your character describe how they would react seeing them for the first time.
- Day 7: Describe what your life would be like now that the war is occurring. Reference information from today's lessons to support your answer.
- Day 8: Explain how your country is innocent for the start of the war. Make sure to include Bias in your response.
- Day 9: Status update on your character. What is happening in their life as a result of the war? Positive or negative be detailed in describing your characters life.
- Day 10: Describe how you feel about the Russians leaving the war and the Americans entering the war.
- Day 11: The war is over, how do you feel about the Versailles Treaty?
