## Interview Questions

- How much experience do you have hosting events?
- What kinds of events do you have experience hosting?
- Tell me more about these experiences.
  - What inspired you to put on this event?
  - What is the scale of this/these events?
    - How did you determine the size?
  - **Walk me through your process of planning events?**
  - Biggest challenges faced?
    - With this/these challenges, is there anything you think could have helped make the process a bit smoother?
  - **What tools, if any, did you use for planning? (organizing)**
- How did you reach your intended audience with information about your event?
  - What tools/technologies/social media/other did you use for **outreach**?
  - Was there a financial investment in the promotion of the event? If so, how much?
    - How did you determine this budget?
  - Did you feel like you reached your desired event size/scale?
- **Magic Wand:** If there is one thing you would add or change about any of the tools you used or event process in general, what would it be?
- Do you ever collect feedback from attendees on hosted events? If so, how did you collect this information?
- Is there anything I didn't ask about that you would like to share?
