RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Organize the results and discussion section by stating the results of your study. Discuss each finding in the same sequence as presented, providing your interpretation of what they mean in the larger context of the problem.

HEADING TITLE

The heading title should be written in Times New Roman 10, **bold**, and UPPERCASE EACH WORD.

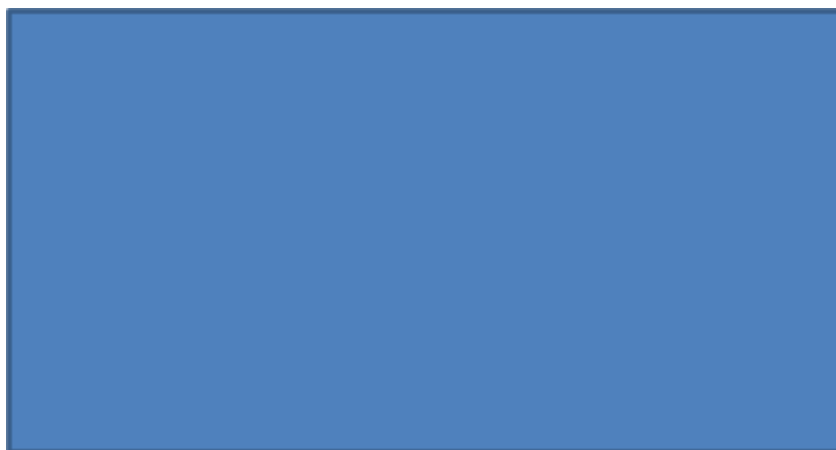
