Cost for Non-members: *1	Non-members are not eligible for prizes, and will pay either \$77 or \$90 at the course; registration is still due by May 3 rd
Whom to Pay:	 Entrants pay the prize fund to SCGL, not the golf course (\$10) Methods of payment: Venmo payments must be made to '@Matthew-H-11. Cash must be given to Matt Helton Checks must be made out to 'Space Club Golf League' and must be given to Matt Helton in person
When to Pay:	Deadline for \$10 prize fund payment is May 3 rd ; please contact Matt Helton (matthew.d.helton@boeing.com) if an exception needs to be made For this FD all greens fees are being paid at the course. This is a change from our normal process, so please remember when you arrive that payment will be due to the HC. If you have an active GHIN, make sure you have a way of displaying that (physical card, phone app, etc.) as your rate will be \$13 cheaper.

Format:

Stroke play: there will be two flights, with prize winners in each flight.

Rule clarifications:

- Winter rules apply (lift clean and place within 6 inches; NO relief in bunkers or hazards)
- Standard OB rules apply: if you hit your tee shot beyond white stakes, you must re-hit from the original location with a 1-stroke penalty (i.e. if you hit OOB on your tee shot, you must re-hit and you will be laying 3 from that spot)
- Lost balls that are hit into areas that are not marked with white, red or yellow stakes (i.e. bushes, trees, fescue, etc.) can be played as 'Kayak rules' (lateral penalty)

Tees:

2 options:

- White tees (6094 yards, 68.7/121)
- Gold tees (5439 yards, 65.5/111)

The purpose of the multi-tee option is to allow players to select the tees that best fit their distance. The spirit of the rule is NOT to select a shorter tee because you think you can score better against the handicap system.

According to the HC scorecard, those who drive the ball further than 220 yards are suggested to play white tees, and those under 200 yards are suggested to play gold tees. If you're between 200-220, it's up to you.

If you play the shorter tee, your course handicap will be reduced. For instance, if you are a 7.9 index over 18 holes, your course handicap would be 6 from the white tees; from the gold tees your course handicap would be 2; so you lose 4 shots against the field by playing the shorter tee.

If you play the gold tees and want to be eligible for KPs (1 on each 9) you MUST move back to the white tee for those 2 holes. You will not get a handicap adjustment. You have the option of playing from the gold tee, but you will not be eligible for KP prizes.

2. Prizes:

There are two flights of players, based on handicap. Each flight will receive its own payouts for the same set of prizes.

The dollar payouts listed here are only approximate and are based on the attendance figures from recent field days.

Ties are broken by awarding prizes to the player who had the best net score on the #1 handicap hole; if both players make the same net score, we will go to the #2 handicap hole and so on until there is a winner.

NOTE: This year there is no restriction on multiple prizes; if you win a low net prize and have the longest drive and a KP, you can collect all (per the league vote).
