The maximum similarity allowed is 30%, verified through Turnitin. Authors are encouraged to prepare their manuscript using this template and ensure that their submission adheres to the formatting standards of *Jurnal Pharma Bhakta*.

RESULT

Illustrations of research results may be presented in paragraph form or organized into sub-sections. Graphs, tables, or figures may be used. Only findings that are meaningful and relevant to the research objectives should be reported. Figure or graph titles should be written in 11-pt font and placed below the figure or graph, accompanied by the reference. Tables should be written in Times New Roman, 11-pt font, single spacing, with a 0.5-pt space below the table title. Table titles should be written in 12-pt bold font and placed above the table. Tables should not use vertical lines. Table numbering uses Arabic numerals (1, 2, ...) placed below the table, along with table notes if applicable.

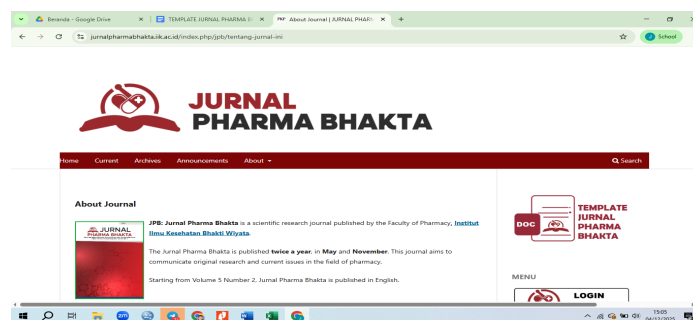


Figure 1. Sample picture
