

Allergens A friend/partner has an allergic reaction and anaphylactic shock ensues. Protective conditions: · first aid kit with an inhaler & EpiPen Lose a friend/partner.	Unsanitary Conditions Water sources have been contaminated. Everyone gets diarrhea or worse. Protective conditions: · must have TP & soap AND one of the following... · house has an electric pump well & generator · iodine or water filter; survivalist can create a solar still if you have a tarp; fire supplies to boil water Lose 2 rations each. Lose friend/partner (random).	Lost Teen A lone teen found your group and asks for food. Discuss allowing the teen to join your group. You might give a meal (give up one ration) and direct the teen where to search for another group to join. The teen would need 1 ration daily, so place this card with your friend/partners if the teen joins. If you later lose a friend/partner at random thru a disaster, this teen could also be lost, except it won't storm off disgruntled or hot-headed. It's not diabetic.	Petitioners Area conditions: You stayed in the home area where people know and trust you. A neighbor couple is having a hard time making it on their own and asks to join your group. You can choose to gain two friend/partners if you decide you have enough food to support them. Draw two friend/partner cards at random if they are available. If only 1 card is available, take that card, but the couple will still need 2 rations daily.
Hotheadedness There's a heated argument within your group. Someone decides to leave. Protective conditions: · You have a mediator, so you'll be able to work it out. · You have a decision-making expert / charismatic leader in your group. Lose a friend/partner.	Hopelessness Debilitating depression is setting in for one friend/partner. Protective condition: · You have a psychologist / crisis social worker in your group, so you'll be able to work it out. Lose a friend/partner.	Disgruntlement One friend/partner feels they are always outvoted and wants to leave. Protective conditions: · You have a mediator, so you'll be able to work thru conflict effectively. · You have a decision-making expert / charismatic leader in your group. Lose a friend/partner.	Refugees Area conditions: Your area has experienced recent legal or illegal immigration resulting from prolonged drought or families fleeing war. Groups of refugees come into your area. You can choose to gain a friend/partner and give up 5 rations to support the new arrival who needs extra nutrition. If you accept them, draw randomly a friend/partner card if any are left, which could include roles of those who died or left the group.
