

Canvas Grading Schemes

In addition to the default grade scheme, Canvas users can create course and assignment level grading schemes. Course-level grade schemes will change the overall final course grade scheme. Assignment-level grade schemes are only applied to selected individual assignments.

Exploring Different Grading Schemes


At the course-level, the disproportionate 100-point scale may be adjusted by setting a percentage such as 50 as the minimum grade. This configuration makes "gradations of the letter scale more proportionate... [requiring] the same degree of improvement from an F to a D as we would require to move from a B to an A" (Feldman, 2019, pp.84-85). Alternatively, the 0-4 grading scale simplified letter grade correlation to a single digit number.




If you are only applying the new grading scheme to selected individual assignments, verify that the Enable course grading scheme box in course settings is NOT checked. This will maintain a standard overall course grade scheme for the final grade.




Apply Grade Schemes to Individual Assignments

Select Assignments in the course navigation menu. Go to the assignment group, and select the plus (+) sign to create a new assignment or edit an existing assignment.






Input the assignment title, due date, and points and select the More Options button. If you are using the 0-4 Grading Scale, the assignment points should be set to 4.



Add the assignment description and set the Display grade as to Letter Grade. Click on the View Grade Scheme link.



Click on the **Select Another Scheme** link and select the new grade scheme. Click on the **Use this Grading Standard** button.





Grading Assignments and Canvas Grade Schemes

When you grade individual student assignments with the new grading scheme, students will see the point value and descriptive narrative relative to the points earned.
