1. Banners can be displayed at any of the following locations. Banners should not be larger than  $4' \times 6'$ .

## \$500 FOR 12 MONTHS; RENEWABLE YEARLY.

- On the fence as spectators enter the stadium, generating maximum exposure to fans entering events and community members who use the facility
- In the fieldhouse, which houses volleyball matches, boys and girls basketball,
  Cheerleading, and Wrestling
- At the tennis courts, which is visible to the access road to the school, the fans viewing the matches, and the community members who use the facility.
- on the fence line of the baseball field or softball field.
- 2. All payments should be directed to Albemarle Athletics, and will be used for improvements to the program your organization chooses to support. Full payment must be received prior to installation of banners. All donations are final and no refunds will be given.
- 3. Banners will be displayed for 12 months following receipt of payment and either renewed or removed at the end of 12 months of installation.
